

Alateen groups in Massachusetts – Area 25

Alateen is a fellowship of young Al-Anon members, usually teenagers, whose lives have been affected by someone else's drinking. Young people come together to:

- Share experience, strength and hope with each other
- Discuss their difficulties
- Learn effective ways to cope with their problems
- Encourage one another
- Help each other understand the principles of the Al-Anon/Alateen program
- Learn how to use Al-Anon's Twelve Steps and Alateen's Twelve Traditions

Alateen members learn:

- Compulsive drinking is a disease
- They can detach themselves emotionally from the drinker's problems while continuing to love the person
- They are not the cause of anyone else's drinking or behavior
- They cannot change or control anyone but themselves
- They have spiritual and intellectual resources with which to develop their own potentials, no matter what happens at home
- They can build satisfying and rewarding life experiences for themselves

Alateen members are helped when they:

- Attend meetings on a regular basis
- Make telephone contact with other Alateen members
- Read Al-Anon/Alateen literature
- Have another Alateen member as a sponsor
- Apply the Twelve Steps of recovery to their lives
- Become involved in Al-Anon service work

Alateen meetings are held in church halls, school rooms or other suitable places (many times in the same building as an Al-Anon group, but in a separate room). Every meeting has at least two active, adult members of Al-Anon who serve as sponsors for the group, guiding and sharing knowledge of the [Twelve Steps](#) and [Twelve Traditions](#). Every sponsor goes through a certification process by AFG of Mass. to become an "Al-Anon Member Involved in Alateen Service" (AMIAS).
